



Jewellery

Parents are asked not to send children to school wearing jewellery. This is on safety grounds as rings, necklaces, earrings etc. can be hazardous for both the wearer and others.

Children are not allowed to wear earrings during any PE activity. Neither are they allowed to cover jewellery with tape. Please ensure that your child can take their earrings out for PE sessions; if they cannot, please remove them before the children come to school on the days when they have PE or after school sports clubs.

- By insisting that my child wears certain items of jewellery (e.g. small stud earrings), I acknowledge that I am acting against advice and accept that the Governors and staff of Godinton Primary School are not liable for any injury which may occur to my child and which comes as a direct consequence of wearing jewellery.
