



Admissions for Pre-School Age Children

This information is for parents with children **born between 1 September 2014 and 31 August 2015**, who will be due to start school in September 2019.

If your child isn't old enough to start school yet you may register an interest by contacting our school office. Please note that registering an interest **does not** give your child priority for a place at our school.

Applications for a place at Godinton Primary School are made by completing a Reception Common Admissions Form (RCAF). Parents can do this online at www.kent.gov.uk/ola, usually between November and January. If you do not have access to the internet you can request a paper copy of the application form from the school office.

The RCAF must be completed and submitted by the deadline indicated on the form for your child to be considered at any primary school.

The number of children admitted into the Foundation year group (Reception Classes) at Godinton Primary School is 60. If more than 60 pupils wish to join our Foundation year group, places will be allocated according to our Admission Oversubscription Criteria.
