Build a 3D model of a lighthouse. You could use construction (Lego, blocks etc) or junk modelling.

Read a selection of seaside themed books. Can you include:

- fiction,
- non-fiction
- poetry

Pick your favourite and write a book review.

Create a picture of a seaside landscape.

Look at some pictures online for inspiration. You can use any medium of your choice (pencils, paint, pastels, felt pens, collage).

Imagine that something super exciting has happened at the beach, e.g. a discovery in the sand, a washed up creature, a shipwreck, a whale/dolphin spotting etc. Write a **newspaper** article about the event. We learnt about these last half term! Remember to include: a newspaper name, headline, picture and caption. Also consider how the story is laid out in columns.

Draw and label an animal that you might see at the seaside.

Challenge: Can you write a few facts about your chosen creature.

Our superhero this term is Greta Thunburg. Can you research who she is and write 3 or more facts about why she is special.

Choose a beach from around the world and compare it with a beach from the UK. What is the same? What is different?

Write, draw or stick pictures to show what you have found.

If you are able to take a trip to the seaside, use your senses to make a list of the things you can see, hear, smell, feel and possibly taste!
