Mathletics

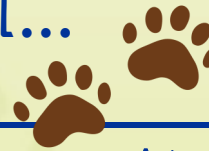
A task will set on Mathletics each week. You can use the games and challenges available on Mathletics as often as you like. The more, the better! Practice the times tables facts that have been sent home.

Eg: while, when, before, after or since.

Multiplication stories

Write 3 multiplication stories for the 4 times table
Eg: There were 10 flowers growing in a field, each flower had 4 petals.
How many petals altogether?

Draw or collage

Draw a picture using different shades or textures.
Are there any artists that use shades in their work?
