## Weekly homework tasks

You must complete three squares in a row, passing vertically, horizontally or diagonally through the middle square.

Carry out some dinosaur fossil research using the questions below as a starting point.

What is your dinosaur? What does it look like? Who discovered its fossils? Where and when were the fossils discovered?

Harry, Ron and Hermione are friends and look after each other. Can you write about an extra special time when you were a good friend.

Make a model or presentation (power-point, poster or a talk) explaining the water cycle.

What happens to the water at each stage?

What scientific words are used?

Create a representation of an imaginary ogre. This can be either 2D or 3D

Write a magical story making sure you include a beginning, middle and end.

You may use Harry Potter characters if you wish.

Using your proportion skills, choose a member of your family and draw a pencil portrait of them. Make sure you show a good likeness.

Write a conversation between you and a friend / celebrity. Make sure that you include all the correct punctuation.

Make up your own ukulele composition to share with the class.

Make a word search or crossword using the spellings that you are currently learning. Use a dictionary to help with meanings of the words.
