## Weekly homework tasks

### Reading

Take care to spell them correctly.</p>	<p><b><u>Art</u></b></p> <p>Look at your own features in a mirror. Can you draw a self-portrait and think of some amazing similes to go with it? (eg: Hair as dark as coal.)</p>	<p><b><u>Poor Ruskin!</u></b></p> <p>Think about some of the ways people would be feeling if someone was bullying them. Can you design an anti-bullying poster with explanations of why it is so terrible.</p>
<p><b><u>Sound</u></b></p> <p>Can you make an instrument from recycled materials? It has to make at least two different notes.</p>	<p><b><u>Selfish Elvis</u></b></p> <p>Can you design your own ball game that involves at least 3 players? Write the rules and the aim of the game so others can learn your game.</p>	<p><b><u>Story Time</u></b></p> <p>Read an adventure story and talk about what you like. What problem did the hero overcome? How bad was the villain? Etc.</p>
<p><b><u>Direct speech</u></b></p> <p>Write a paragraph using the correct punctuation for direct speech using inverted commas. Remember 'said' is banned!</p>	<p><b><u>Money Matters</u></b></p> <p>Imagine you have been given £100. Make a list of all the things you could buy using real prices and record how many items you could buy and any change you'd have left.</p>	<p><b><u>Krindlekrax</u></b></p> <p>Can you make a 3D model of a crocodile. You can use any material like boxes, foam, lego etc.</p>
