Reading

Challenge yourself to read at least once every day. Share some of your reading with an adult at home and answer their questions about the storyline, the characters and the author's word choice. Log onto **Oxford Owl** for books.

Go on a grapheme hunt through a reading book and make a list of words you find with different graphemes for ai, ee, ie, oa, oo.

Act out a story with your family or toys – you could make a play!

Log in to Purple Mash for your 2DO and complete the Computing quiz set.

Writing

Practice your Year 2 spelling words.

Write a poem that has rhyming words in about your favourite things.

Log in to Purple Mash for your 2Do. Write instructions on how to make a rich Tudor house. Use the key features: main heading, list of items needed, diagrams, numbered steps, bullet points, imperative verbs, capital letters, full stops.

After doing something interesting write a recount of what you did.



Maths

Practise your times tables (2, 5, 10, 3 and beyond!) in any fun way you can.

Construct a tally chart of your families favourite food/toy etc and make a bar graph or a pictogram to go with this. Write a sentence about what the most popular was and a sentence about what the least popular was.

Log in to Purple Mash for your 2DO on statistics.

Complete Mathematics activities on shape, space and measures.



Learning Adventure

Science Skills

Collect a variety of materials eg water, wax, bread, paper, metal, etc. Write a prediction about what you think will happen when they are heated and what you think will happen when they are cooled. Look at the changes made by the different materials when they are heated or cooled. Are these reversible or non reversible? Sort these into a chart. Write about the changes you observed. **WARNING:** You must have an adult to help you carry out the investigation!

Creative Adventure

Log onto Purple Mash and complete your animation for the Great Fire of London.

Design and create a bridge to transport a toy car across a gap without falling. What sort of bridge will you make? Suspension, beam, truss, arch, cantilever or cable stay? Include materials needed and tools you will use in your design.

Learning Adventure

History Skills

Create the front page of a magazine for tourists in London in 1666, how would it be the same as your one for 2020? How are they different?

PE

Travel around: use both feet in a straight line, moving from one foot to the other. Then travel with some kind of rotation: choose the height at which you travel. Now find some other ways that you can travel using your feet: hopping, skipping, jumping, gallop and without using your feet.

Write a letter to your friends telling them about what you have been doing at home.
