### Bumblebees and Dragonflies' Unexpected Adventure Trail Weeks 1-2

Instead of going to school for a short while, you can go on a 'Unexpected Adventure Trail' to make sure that you keep up with your learning. Your teachers have set out some tasks for you to complete but where you take your learning to after that, is up to you. You can extend it in any way you like.

So put on your backpack of essential skills and get going!

Challenge yourself to read at least once every day. Share some of your reading with an adult at home and answer their questions about the storyline, the characters and the author's word choice. You could write a review of a book you have read, write an additional chapter for your favourite book or put together a character study. Alternatively, create a non-chronological report to summarise an information text you have enjoyed: this could be a book or an online article.

### Writing

Character description: Create a new fictional character for Krindlekrax. Use adjectives, similes and sentence starters to describe a new character (maybe a sister for Ruskin or a new friend for Elvis and Sparkey?). Describe their personality as well as their appearance.

Re-write a traditional tale in the style of a play script. Remember to include: cast list, prop list, setting description, narrator, stage directions, speech and your colons!

Film a puppet show. Write a script for your characters or film a puppet show and email it to us. You can use your cuddly toys or make some.

### Maths

Log in to your Mathletics and enjoy the fun activities and tasks on statistics.

Log in to multiverse and don't forget to keep practising your times tables.

Can you come up with a question that you can collect data for like we did in class. (What's your favourite fruit?) Create a bar chart representing this data from people you have called and asked. Can you create questions to compare this data? (What is the difference between the amount of people who like strawberry and cherry? What is the total votes for mango and cherry?)



# Learning Adventure Science Skills

Explore how sound travels. Write an explanation of how sound vibrations are heard by the ear. Find out if sound travels faster through a solid, liquid or gas (air).

Can you create a string telephone using the cups and string provided? You might need an adult to help make the hole in the cup. How does the tension in the string change the sound? Does it change when you tie a knot? Does it change when the string is loose? Is it different when you hold it away from your ear?

## Learning Adventure History Skills

Find out who invented the telephone and created the amazing invention of sound travelling around the world.

Can you create a fact sheet including as many interesting facts as you can.

Think about questions you would want to ask him if he was still alive. Explain to him how telephone have changed in modern times.

# Learning Adventure Geography Skills

Create a map of your garden or house and write a list of instructions using compass points to get from one side to the other.

#### Creative Adventure

Log in to Purple Mash and complete an animation on 2animate of Krindlekrax chasing Ruskin on Lizard Street.

Create a collage of your favourite character in Krindlekrax using lots of different materials.

Print a photo of yourself. Cut it in half, straight down the middle then stick on half onto plain paper and draw the missing reflection to complete your portrait.

Create a dance routine using large, small, fast and slow movements. Add a balance and turn within it. Perform it to someone in your house.
