Read the story at home if you have it and watch some animated versions of the story on YouTube (a parent or guardian must help you to find this).

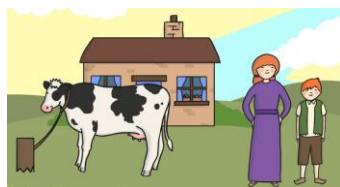

Extra challenge! Can you include some conjunctions in your writing? (and, because, but, so)

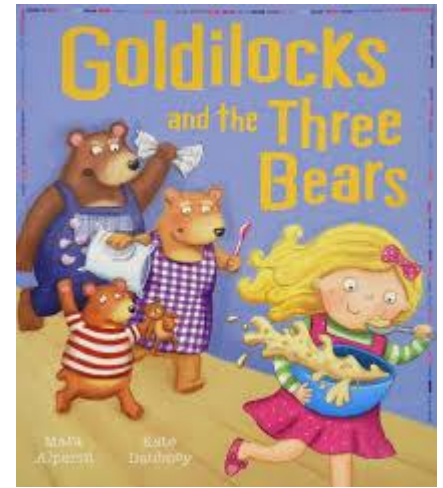
Task 2:
