Guests may request gear for snorkelling as well as sea kayaks, wind surfing, paddle boards, an array of sail boats, or sign on for an exhilarating session of water skiing, wakeboarding or tubing.

Snorkelling trips to nearby Bird Island & a haven for wildlife & are offered weekly. The resort can also arrange private excursions, diving trips and eco-tours further out into Antigua's waters, which are known for their well-preserved coral reefs, teeming with marine life.
