Mrs Coles "I have enjoyed walking through the woods making the most of this lovely weather. I have also been busy baking raspberry and passionfruit muffins, yummy!"





We are using our time very differently now than when we were at school.



Can you make a time diary for your day and write what you are doing at these times? Draw some pictures too if you can.
