Task 2: Go on a 'Summer Senses Nature Walk'.


What do you see?

This sheet can be found in the Year 1 area. If you don't have a printer you can record straight into your Unexpected Adventure exercise books.





Task 3: How many words can you think of that rhyme with these summer words?




