With an adult have a go at making the split pin squirrel that in your pack. Take a look at this [video](#) to learn more about how squirrels move around the forest.



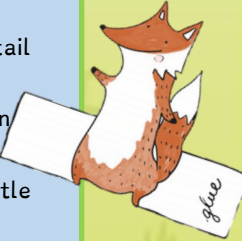
## Grow Together Foxes Tail
