Design a poster to advertise the importance of dental hygiene. The poster should include the names and purposes of each tooth type!

Write a speech that you can present in class that defines the impact of cocoa plantations for the Earth and humanity. What solutions could solve this global problem.

Write a short story about a magical place. Use up-levelled vocabulary, adjectives, prepositional phrases and expanded noun phrases to make your writing exciting.

Create a fact file or poster about the Amazon rainforest. Include information on climate, biodiversity (animals and plants), land use and people.

Create a sculpture of a book character of your choice. Think about what items you could use to achieve the result you want. You might use general household items, clay, playdough, paper or card.

Create "organ flash cards" for each part of the digestive system. Each card should include a picture of the organ and its function.
