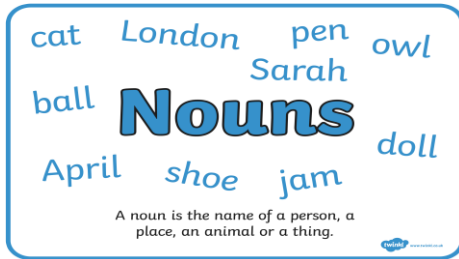


Adjectives and Nouns

Support Sheet

A noun phrase is a group of two or more words which includes a noun (an object); for example- the dog

An **expanded noun phrase** is when this also includes adjectives to describe the noun eg- the furry, black dog

If this is then put into a sentence to include an expanded noun phrase you would write...

The **furry, black dog** **sat** **as still as a statue** on the grass.

To make this into a sentence, you would need to include a **capital letter**, **expanded noun phrase**, a **verb** and a **full stop**. The sentence must make sense.

To make a sentence more interesting you would include **extra information**.
