Below you will find your daily learning tasks for you to complete at home. Try to complete them each day so that you can keep on top of your work. Reading

Make sure that you read today for at least 20 minutes. This could be by yourself or to an adult.

Times Tables

Spend at least 20 minutes practising your times tables. Focus on those you are working on in class.

Spelling

Spend 20 minutes practising the words from your spelling list.



Maths

Today our lesson is based on subtracting 4 digit numbers with more than one exchange, building on our knowledge from last week. If you are able to, join Miss Brooker's live zoom sessions to work through the slides together, or see them posted below in our year 4 area. You should all be becoming more confident with this column method now, so try challenging yourself with the questions you choose to complete!

English— GPS

Last week we touched on apostrophes for possession and the difference between singular and plural. Today you are going to focus on apostrophe for plural possession. Work through the slides completing the tasks as you go. There is a challenge at the end of the help slides to complete in your unexpected adventure books—This will test your memory of some other GPS skills we have looked at this year!

Guided Reading

This week we are continuing to follow Daisy and her rainforest adventure. Read through the initial slides before reading the text. There is an example of answering in FULL sentences, using the question within your answer. The first questions are for you to simply think about as you read and do not need to be written down. The questions for you to answer in your book are at the END of the slides.
