Below you will find your daily learning tasks for you to complete at home. Try to complete them each day so that you can keep on top of your work. Your teachers will give you feedback to show you how you are doing, some of this will be on the website. Your parents will also need to email your teachers with photos of your work so that they can reply and give you some personalised feedback. Make sure you let your teachers know if there is anything that you need help with.

## Reading

Make sure that you read today for at least 20 minutes. This could be by yourself or to an adult.

## Times Tables

Spend at least 20 minutes practising your times tables. Focus on those you are working on in class.

## Spelling

Spend 20 minutes practising the words from your spelling list.



## Maths

Maths today looks at "diving deeper" into our column subtraction topic. Work through the slides as usual and complete the practice questions if you feel you need more practice. Then choose how deep you will dive into our mastery style maths work. You can complete more than one group of questions if you would like to challenge yourself!

## English

This lesson requires you to think back on the knowledge you already have, from year 1,2 and 3, about direct speech. Today you will recap your knowledge, adding one new element of identifying reporting clauses. You will look at what direct speech is, what punctuation is needed and when and how it is used.

## Guided Reading

This week we are continuing to follow Daisy and her rainforest adventure. Read through the initial slides before reading the text. There is an example of answering in FULL sentences, using the question within your answer. The first questions are for you to simply think about as you read and do not need to be written down. The questions for you to answer in your book are at the END of the slides.

## Spelling

The last few lessons, you have worked on uses the suffixes ing, ed, en and er. Today you are going to practice spellings words using these suffixes. You must spots the correct spellings and work your way through the maze. There is also a dictation activity for you to complete if you have a grown up or sibling to read these sentences out to you.
