The feedback here describes what the class did well and how we can make our work even better.

#### Maths

We have seen some more fantastic maths work this week! Please remember to label your maths questions clearly within your book. This helps us to see which question you are attempting, making it easier for us to offer you support. It is also a good idea to use the title of your questions within your book—For example "Feeling confident questions".

#### Feedback

Remember to ask your grown ups to send in pictures of your work regularly for me to offer relevant feedback. You do not always need to send in work daily, but if you have a specific piece of work you would like to show of, or a question you are struggling with, please send it in for me to respond as quickly as I can. It is lovely to see the work you are achieving, but I am also here to give you support on the questions you find tricky. Just like in class, it is always ok to ask for help!

### Science

We have some excellent scientists within our year group and you are all working brilliantly. We have seen some great tooth images and you all explained the different tooth types correctly and how this can link to an animals diet. As a challenge, can you tell me the diet of a human and how this links to our different types of teeth? Try to include our key scientific vocabulary!

## Guided Reading

You are all working hard with guided reading and the majority of you are engaging with it well. You must continue to answer your questions in full sentences as you would in class. Home learning is tricky, but we expect the same effort you put in in the classroom. Lots of you are still sending in photos of the first 3 questions—remember these are "thinking" questions for you to consider whilst you read and do not need to be written down. The questions that you must answer are on the last slide of your guided reading slides.
