Phonics: Practice your daily phonics using the flash card you have in your phonics pack sent home. We have learnt all of the phase 2 Base camp tasks also support this for further ideas. We will now be learning new digraph sounds from phase 3. A digraph is a sound represented by two letter shapes such as 'oo' in moon, 'sh' in ship or 'oa' in coat.

Today's instructions will have the links you need and the activities can be found on the task grid.




Learning Adventure:
