2. Reading

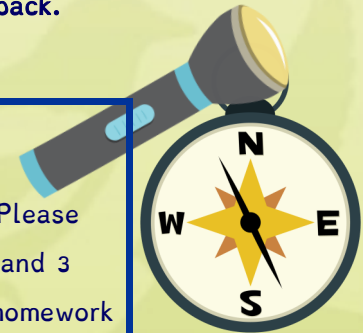

2. Rainbow Fish Comprehension with Mrs Jones

Watch story time with Mrs Jones and then have a look at the Rainbow Fish comprehension task. You can watch Mrs Jones's video again when you are doing your task to help you.

1. Phonics

This week we are recapping phase 5 sounds. Please spend a few minutes practising your Phase 2 and 3 sounds everyday from your sound mats, in your homework books or with Mrs Clark's video below the grid. Our sound of the day is the split digraph 'ay'. Use Mrs Jones's video and task sheet to do your phonics lesson.



4. Maths

We are continuing subtraction today using our counting backwards method with a number line to support us. Please make sure you have written your number line before you join Mrs Jones video for our maths lesson. You can watch it more than once if you need to. Your question sheet is also on the grid, have a go at the subtraction using your number line and if you are feeling confident have a go at the challenge!
