Reading

Times Tables

Spend at least 20 minutes practising your times tables. Focus on 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

Spelling

Spend 20 minutes practising the words from your spelling list.
Challenge yourself by practising words from past lists.



Maths

Your tasks today are looking at comparing numbers. Remember the phrases: greater than, less than or equal to. Watch the video and the lesson introduction for support with this.

Guided Reading

Write a conversation between you and the boy advising him whether he should go the short way or the long way like his mother said. Remember to give reasons and use inverted commas for speech.

Learning Adventure

As we know, Krindlekrax is an adventure story. We are going to look at the features of an adventure story and look at other adventure stories.

Task: Write an adventure about going to outer space. Remember to use both long and descriptive sentences with adjectives and short snappy ones to ensure a fast pace.

Challenge: Use a rhetorical question within your story. Examples:
