
# Foxes and Otters' Unexpected Adventure Trail

#### 1. Phonics

This week we are recapping phase 5 sounds. Our sound of the day is the split digraph 'ou'. Use Mrs Jones's video and task sheet to do your phonics lesson.

We are continuing subtraction today using our part whole and number bond knowledge to bridge to 10 to help us find our answer.
