

Learning Adventure activity Wednesday 20th January

Today you are going to find out about animals that live in a cold snowy part of the world called the Arctic. We found out some of these animals in the story today. Animals who live in the Arctic have to make sure they can survive the very cold weather. We will find out how polar bears, snow foxes and reindeer have adapted to live in cold environments. The narrator explains their key adaptations and we see them in their natural environment, the very cold Arctic.
