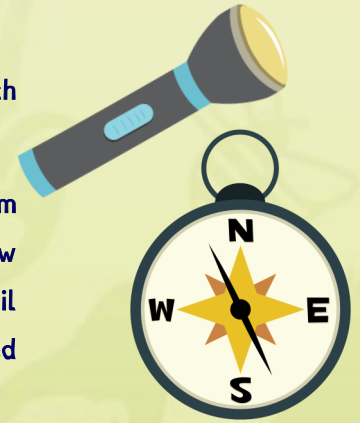


Ladybirds and Butterflies Unexpected Adventure Trail

Even though we can't be at school at the moment, it is still important for you to continue with your learning at home so that we don't miss out on learning opportunities.

Below you will find your daily learning tasks for you to complete at home. Try to complete them each day so that you can keep on top of your work. Your teachers will give you feedback to show you how you are doing, some of this will be on the website. Your parents will also need to email your teachers with photos of your work so that they can reply and give you some personalised feedback. Make sure you let your teachers know if there is anything that you need help with.



Reading

Make sure that you read today for at least 15 minutes. This could be by yourself or to an adult.

Times Tables

Spend at least 15 minutes practising your times tables. Focus on the 2, 5 and 10 x tables.

Spelling

Spend 15 minutes practising the words from the spelling list at the front of your homework book.

PE

You have an extra optional activity today. Log onto imoves using the details sent out via parentmail.

Maths

Now it is time for us to begin looking at our times tables, beginning with the 2x tables. First watch the recap video on doubling; two groups of an object or amount, as this is what the 2x table does. We will be exploring the 2's using lots of different problems and methods. Every answer will be in the 2x table. Use arrays or groups of objects you have at home to make the problem if you get stuck. There is also a short video showing you how to use a numberline to multiply. Watch the White Rose video clip by clicking on the link on the pdf document. This will explain things in more detail. When you have watched this, complete the questions in your Unexpected Adventure books You will find this on the pdf document too. The questions get progressively more challenging as you work through them. If you get stuck, look at the video again to help you out. Don't forget to complete your Mathletics tasks too!

Learning Adventure

Task 1– We are continuing our story by using the words collected to write the next part. Use the example to help if you are unsure, or listen to the audio again. Read what you have already written first to make sure what you are writing makes sense.

Task 2– We are going to continue looking at contractions. Have a go at correcting the contractions Shrek has written. If you need the answers they are on a separate pdf.

Task 3– Your reading today is a recipe for Fruit Salad. If you are feeling hungry and have some spare time, why not have a go at making it yourself, make sure you get permission and help from an adult first.
