Below you will find your daily learning tasks for you to complete at home. Try to complete them each day so that you can keep on top of your work. Reading

Make sure that you read today for at least 20 minutes. This could be by yourself or to an adult. Remember to write in in your diary so you can show us when we get back.

Times Tables

Spend at least 20 minutes practising your times tables. Focus on 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

Spelling

Spend 20 minutes practising the words from your spelling list.
Challenge yourself by practising words from past lists.



Maths

We are now looking at division. Remember, it is the inverse operation so use your knowledge and understanding of times tables to help you with this.

GPS– Suffixes

Remember, a word with a suffix means it has letters at the **end** of the root word.

Task 1: Write the word with the suffixes in the correct places in the text.

Task 2: Write a paragraph using the ly suffix. You can describe the picture, using the words to help you.
