Even though we can't be at school at the moment, it is still important for you to continue with your learning at home so that we don't miss out on learning opportunities.

Below you will find your daily learning tasks for you to complete at home. Try to complete them each day so that you can keep on top of your work. Your teachers will give you feedback to show you how you are doing, some of this will be on the website. Your parents will also need to email your teachers with photos of your work so that they can reply and give you some personalised feedback. Make sure you let your teachers know if there is anything that you need help with.

Reading

Make sure that you read today for at least 20 minutes. This could be by yourself or to an adult.

Times Tables

Spend at least 20 minutes practising your times tables. Focus on the ones you are working on in class.

Spelling

Spend 20 minutes practising the words from your spelling list.



Maths

Today in maths we are going to continue to work through some problem solving challenges which involve division. Remember that the most important part of these questions is that you've carefully read and understood the question. Before completing your independent work, you may wish to listen to the video of Miss Attenborough explaining some of today's tasks.

Once you have taken a look at the teaching slides, move onto the problems that we have given you. You may choose which problems you complete. Make sure that you have shown your working out clearly and written your answers in sentences where needed.

See how many problems you can complete in 20– 30 minutes.

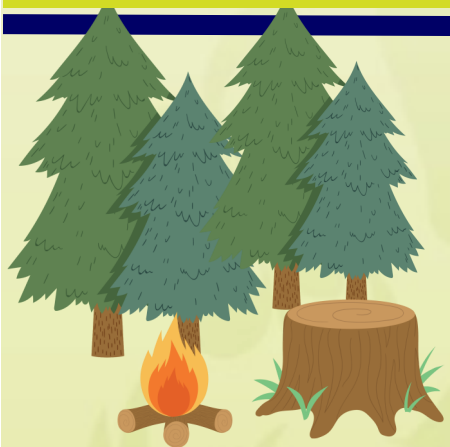
Learning Adventure

Once you have listened to Mr Smith explain today's task, choose whether you are going to complete the bronze, silver or gold task—make sure that you are challenging yourself. When you are writing, you may wish to also have the example diary entry that we have included on the teaching slides. 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Maths Too

Then listen to the video of Miss Attenborough reading chapter 4. We have uploaded a copy of this chapter so you can read along with the video if you wish. It is also helpful to refer back to this copy of the text when you come to answer your questions.

When you are ready, choose whether to answer the bronze, silver or gold questions. Remember that it is important to challenge yourself. If you start on bronze but find them easy, keep going and try some silver questions.
