



## Chapter 6 Vocabulary

Page 82	astounded	to be in shock or greatly surprised.
	matted	(especially of hair, wool, or fur) tangled into a thick mass.
Page 83	<b>singed</b>	to burn something lightly.
Page 84	<b>unfurled</b>	to unroll or become spread out from a rolled or folded state.
Page 85	encrusted	covered or decorated with a hard surface layer.
	distorted	pulled or twisted out of shape; contorted.
Page 86	<b>mangled</b>	to destroy or severely damage something by tearing or crushing.
	furrowed	(of the forehead or face) marked with lines or wrinkles.
Page 87	scapula	technical term for a shoulder blade.
	valve	a device for controlling the passage of fluid or air through a pipe or duct
Page 88	mass-produced	the production of something on a large scale.
	kindred	similar or related.
Page 89	intuition	the ability to understand something instinctively.
	<b>calloused</b>	1. (of a part of the body) having an area of hardened skin. 2. (a person) hardened, insensitive or showing no emotion.
Page 90	juddered	shake and vibrate rapidly and with force.



# singed


VERB: [singe].



**VERB [PAST TENSE]:** to burn something lightly.

**SYNONYMS:** blacken, scorch, sear, char.

**EXAMPLE:** Thaddeus opened the pouch and pulled out a bullet-**singed** envelope.



# unfurled

VERB: [unfurl].



**VERB [PAST TENSE]:** to unroll or become spread out from a rolled or folded state.

**SYNONYMS:** unroll, unfold, unwind, open.

**EXAMPLE:** He opened a draw in the workbench and took out a roll of leather, which he **unfurled** to reveal neat lines of tools.



# mangled

NOUN: [mangle]: a mechanical laundry machine.


VERB: [mangle].



**VERB [PAST TENSE]:** to destroy or severely damage something by tearing or crushing it.

**SYNONYMS:** damage, disfigure, mutilate, maim.

**EXAMPLE:** Robert helped remove the **mangled** cogs and logged them in the workbook.



# calloused

NOUN: [callouses]: a medical condition.



**ADJECTIVE:** 1. (of a part of the body) having an area of hardened skin.

2. (a person) hardened, insensitive or showing no emotion.

**SYNONYMS:** hard, thick, tough, coarse, .

**EXAMPLE:** He ruffled his son's hair with a **calloused** hand.
