The title of our creative day is 'Godinton Grand Designs'. You can respond to this in any way you like and be as creative as possible. Here are some ideas to get you started...

Good ideas often start with a plan. You might want to draw a plan for a building of the future, your ideal bedroom, a garden, a zoo, a shop, a tree house, a piece of furniture, or a den. You could label the features and add information.







You might want to draw some sketches. This could be a sketch of your dream house, a school of the future, a football stadium, a building from the past, an airport or a fantasy building. You might want to think big and plan a whole new town.



Once you've thought through an idea — you might want to have a go at making a model. This could be a junk model made from boxes and other materials you've got at home or you could use something like Lego.

You might want to make a castle, a house, a theme park, a playground, a space station or a fairy palace. Think about the structure and shape. How will you fix the different parts together? How you will decorate your creation? Can you add some moving parts?





You could create a real life den or teepee in your bedroom or in the garden. Or you could create a small model out of natural materials.
