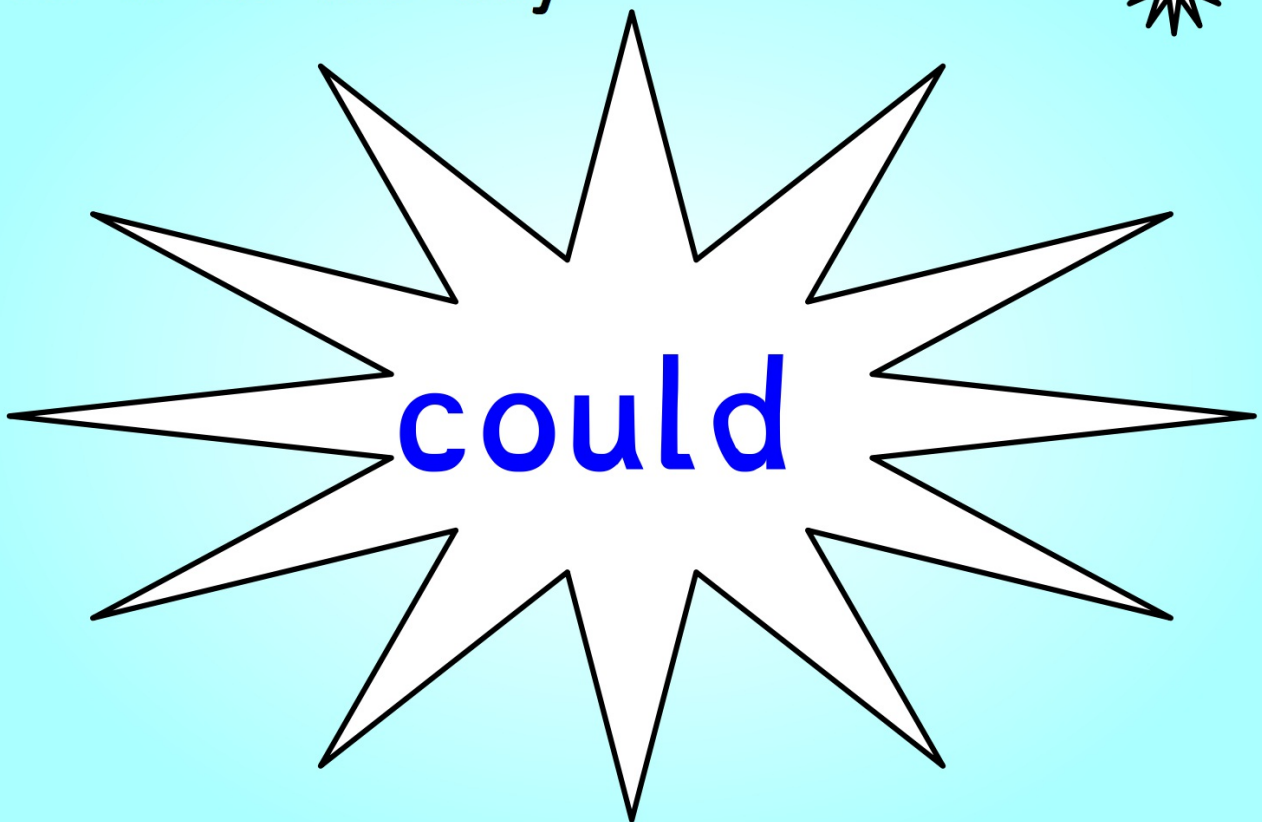

talk → talked

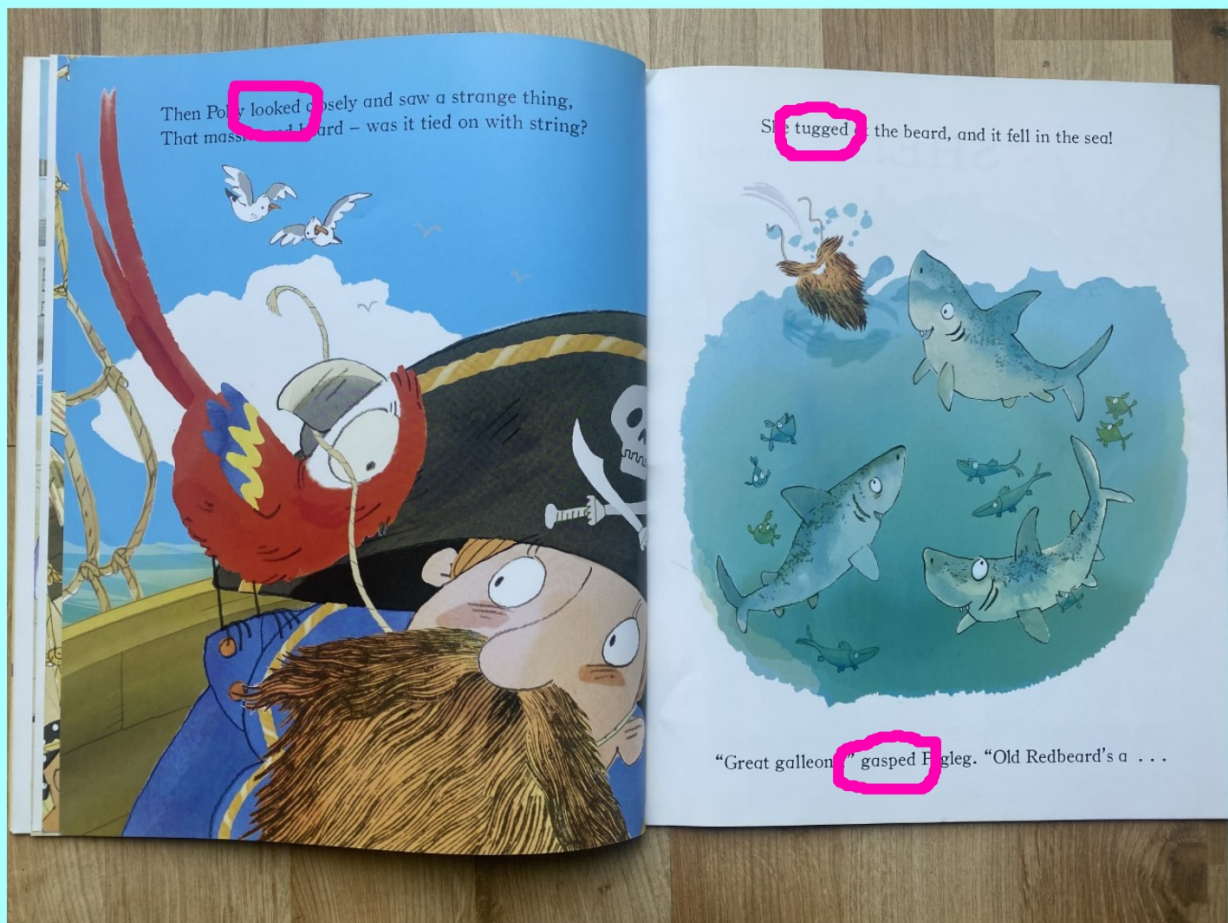
crawl → crawled
