Weekly homework tasks

Reading

Off on the trail...



You must complete three squares in a row, passing vertically, horizontally or diagonally through the middle square.

Describe the evolution of communication. Present this in whichever way you would like; e.g. 3-D model, visual representation, timeline or written explanation.	Create a 2-D piece of artwork showing forces in action.	Choose an environment and create a 3-D model of it. Invent a creature that has the advantageous characteristics that suit that environment.
Bake your own money themed cookies, biscuits or cakes. Take a picture and then write the recipe in your book, using the correct features of an instruction text.	Write a non-fiction text about a species of your choice, explaining their advantageous characteristics and why they are suited to their environment.	Research the evolution of a mammal; e.g. a horse, a whale, a mole, a bat, and present your findings in your chosen form.
Write a letter from Sir Isaac Newton to a friend explaining his new theory on gravity.	You have inherited £1million pounds, but can only keep £200,000. The rest has to 'make a difference' to others. Explain what you would do with it, using software if you wish.	Research a force that we have not studied in class; e.g. magnets, friction, air resistance. Conduct an experiment to show its effects in action, and report your findings.
