Weekly homework tasks

Reading

Read or share a book at least five times a week. This could be your school reading book or a book from home.

Mathletics

Tasks will be set on Mathletics each fortnight. You can use the games and challenges available on Mathletics as often as you like. The more, the better!

Practice counting and simple number bonds.

Spellings

Practice reading the sounds or spellings that have been sent home.

You should practise spelling these words, but there will not be a test.

Off on the trail...



You must complete three squares in a row, passing vertically, horizontally or diagonally through the middle square.

Read Hansel and Gretel and listen out for clues. Can you describe the witch's cottage? What does it look like? What is it made from?

We have learnt about materials like paper, metal, fabric, glass, etc. What materials can you huff and puff down? Record your results. What materials would build a house out of?

Read the Gingerbread Man. What ingredients did they use to make him? Can you bake and decorate a Gingerbread Man?

Many different traditional tales are set in castles. Can you draw or make your very own fairy tale castle? How you do this is entirely up to you. Use whatever you have at home!



Can you re-write a traditional tale with an alternative character, plot or ending? Think about the beginning, middle and end of your new story.

There are lots of different homes in the traditional tales you have read. What type of home do you live in?

Draw a picture and label the house you live in!



Which is your favourite traditional tale? Can you act out it out? You could take a photo and email it to us.

Can you create a picture using 2D shapes? This could be a fairy tale character or scene.



Cinderella always has to do the washing up and is fed up! Write instructions explaining how to wash up so she can get some help.
