## Weekly homework tasks

### Reading

Read or share a book at least five times a week. This could be your school reading book or a book from home.

### Mathletics

A task will set on Mathletics each fortnight. You can use the games and challenges available on Mathletics as often as you like. The more, the better!

Practice counting and simple number bonds.

### Spellings

Practice the sounds or spellings that have been sent home.

Have a look at and learn the words from the list from your list and practice regularly.

## Off on the trail...



You must complete three squares in a row, passing vertically, horizontally or diagonally through the middle

Can you write a description of your character? This could be a superhero or a character from your favourite story. What adjectives could you use to describe your character?

You can draw your character too.

Investigate floating and sinking. Choose objects that are safe to go in the water.

Can you predict what will happen? Will it float? Why/why not? What can you see? What has happened? Which is the heaviest/ lightest?

Can you learn all the phase three digraphs and tricky words? Can you spot them in the books you share at home? You could have a go at writing them down in a list.

Can you explore what happens when you mix colours? You could use food colouring with water, diluted poster paint, chalk. What happens when you mix two colours? What colour do you make?

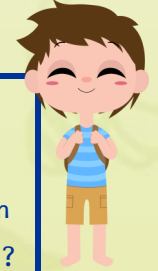
Can you read or listen to lots of traditional tales? What are your favourites? Can you make puppets and retell/act out part of your favourite traditional story?

Can you practice learning numbers that add together to make 10? You can use a ten frame and loose parts, you can write addition equations, you can use bricks or coins.

Can you investigate capacity? Explore different capacities of different containers. Use the vocabulary full/empty/nearly full/nearly empty and half full.

Go on a number hunt and find teen numbers. What numbers have you found? Can you practice ordering numbers on cards to 20.

Can you make a kite or a hanging decoration for your garden? You could take a photo and email it to us.
