Year 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6



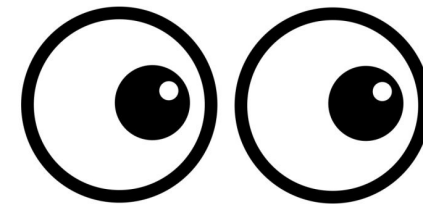

When we come back to school we don't have to stay in our bubbles any more and we can share our toys and equipment but, we do still have some things to remember:

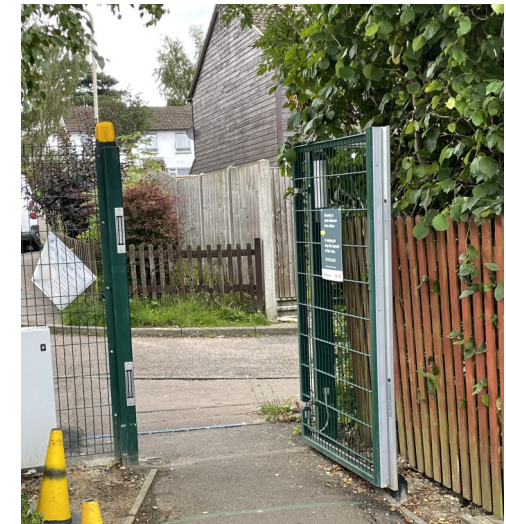


We will be washing and sanitising our hands regularly.
