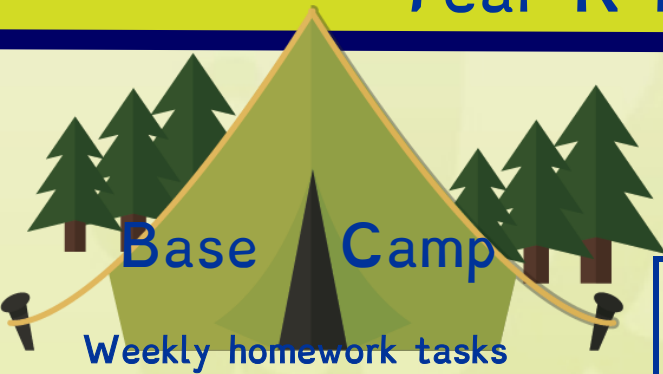


Year R Homework Trail (Term 6 2021–2022)
