RUNS ON THURSDAYS 3.15– 4.15 pm

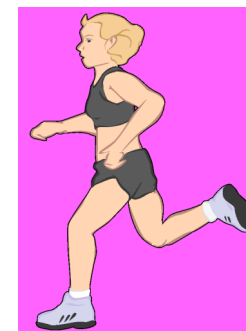
CONTINUES FOR EXISTING MEMBERS ONLY

RUNS ON MONDAYS 3.15–4.15 pm

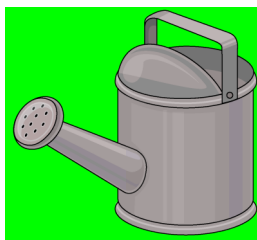
