RUNS ON THURSDAYS 3.15– 4.15 pm

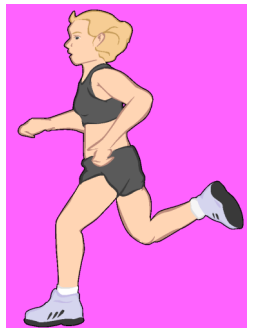
SPACES WILL BE OFFERED TO CHILDREN CURRENTLY ON THE WAITING LIST.
