Weekly homework tasks

Reading

Read or share a book at least five times a week. This could be your school reading book, Monster Phonics eBook or a book from home.

Mathletics

Tasks will be set on Mathletics each week. You can use the games and challenges available on Mathletics as often as you like. The more, the better! Practice addition and subtraction of numbers to 20.

Spellings

Practice reading and spelling the Monster Phonics first 100 High frequency words that have been sent home. There will not be a test, but we write these words all the time in class and we really want the children to work at spelling them correctly.

Off on the trail...



You must complete three squares in a row, passing vertically, horizontally or diagonally through the middle square.

Investigate measurements. Find items of different sizes and compare their lengths. Look at how tall you are in comparison to your grown ups. Create a table to show your results.

Enjoy reading some pirate themed books with your loved ones. Can you discuss the differences between fiction and non-fiction? Give examples and write in your homework book

Design a pirate ship in your book.

Extra challenge: Can you make it? You could use any materials (junk modelling) or construction blocks (Lego, Duplo etc).

Draw a treasure map.

Can you label each of the areas. E.g. forest, volcano, cave, beach etc.

Write a fact file about

- Where it lives
- What it eats
- What type of animal it is
- Interesting facts—min. 2

Create some animal inspired snacks! E.g. grape caterpillars, animal shaped biscuits etc. Can you write a set of instruction on how to make it?

Think about: name, appearance, last seen, what they did wrong and reward.
