## Weekly homework tasks

### Reading

Read or share a book at least five times a week. This could be your school reading book, Monster Phonics ebook, or a book from home.

### Mathletics

You can use the games and challenges available on Mathletics as often as you like. The more, the better!

Practice counting and recognising numbers.

### Phonics

Can you practise clapping the number of syllables in words? Could you try and write some simple CVC words such as cat, pin, pat pot? Perhaps you could photograph yourself forming words in sand, shaving foam or glitter—You could make the shapes with natural materials!
