Children join Miss Talbot in our story time and drama club for children in Year 1. Each week we will share a different picture book and have fun with drama activities connected with it.

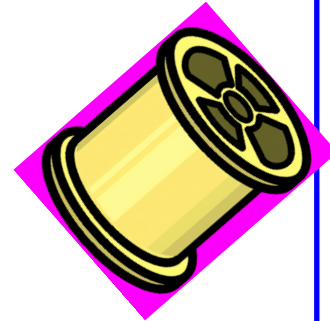
