Discuss your likes/dislikes and recreate your favourite painting.</p>	<p>Can you draw a map of your bedroom? Do some research about a 'Birds Eye View' to see if this can help you.</p>
<p>Can you find out the names of some common flowers? E.g. daisy, sunflower, rose etc. Write a list of as many as you can come up with. You could design a word search or draw pictures too.</p>	<p>Can you retell your favourite traditional tale in your own words? Write the story in your neatest handwriting!</p>	<p>Go out in your garden, or take a walk with your family. What do you see around you? Are there any signs of Autumn/Winter? Draw a picture or create a season collage.</p>
<p>Imagine you were blindfolded. Write some directions explaining how to get from your bedroom to your garden. (Useful vocabulary: forward, back, left, right, step, turn). You could add a diagram/map with arrows to help!</p>	<p>In October we celebrated Black Culture Month. Design a poster to celebrate the life of an inspiring black person past or present.</p>	<p>Can you grow some seeds at home? Cress is a great one to see in 5–7 days. What does it need to help it grow and survive?</p>
