Design a poster to celebrate the life of an inspiring black person past or present.</p>	<p>Which Ancient Greek invention do you think is the most important which we still use today? Research, write about and present information to inform the class about the invention and why you think this.</p>	<p>Create a quiz about daily life in Ancient Greece to test your friend's knowledge.</p>

Create an invention which would help a battlefield surgeon to treat their patients and make them well again.</p>	<p>Draw or paint a picture or scene from Ancient Greek times, e.g. a feast at a rich person's home, priests in the temple, the Gods and Goddesses on Mount Olympus.</p>	<p>Invent an outdoor game for Ancient Greek children to play. Which materials would the game be made from? Write a paragraph to explain how you play the game.</p>
