School Agreement

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As a school we will:

- Create a caring, safe, supportive and stimulating learning environment where our children are happy, fulfilled and reach their potential.
- Value and respect all children; celebrating their achievements.
- Support children in upholding our school values at all times.
- Provide each child with an inclusive, engaging and creative curriculum, where all children are provided with challenge and provide the resources required to access learning appropriately.
- Encourage all children to do their best and have high aspirations for themselves.
- Ensure that our children's wellbeing and mental health is well cared for and that they develop positive feelings of confidence and self-worth.
- Promote high standards of behaviour at all times and take action to address behaviour concerns such as bullying.
- Provide positive play experiences and outdoor learning opportunities.
- Ensure that we fulfil our safeguarding responsibilities and guide our children in the steps they can take to keep themselves safe, including on line.
- Provide children with a range of extra curricular activities and experiences including those which take place off site.
- Work in partnership with parents and carers, welcoming them into the life of the school and keep them regularly informed about school matters and their child's attainment, progress and wellbeing.
- Respond promptly to any concerns and treat parents with respect, courtesy and with an understanding of any needs they may have themselves.
