Godinton Primary School is committed to ensuring digital accessibility for people of all abilities. We strive to make our website accessible and usable for as many people as possible, regardless of technology or ability. This includes ongoing work to align with the Public Sector Bodies (Websites and Mobile Applications) (No. 2) Accessibility Regulations 2018.

We are actively working to increase the accessibility and usability of our website and aim to adhere to the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) version 2.1 AA standard.

Accessibility on this website

We want as many people as possible to be able to use this website. For example, that means you should be able to:

- Navigate most of the website using a keyboard or assistive technologies
- View the site clearly on a range of devices including desktops, tablets, and mobiles
- Zoom in up to 300% without text spilling off the screen
- Understand links and headings without needing to interpret complex language

- Access content using screen readers or voice recognition software (to a large extent)
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How accessible this website is

We know that some parts of the site are not yet fully accessible. For example:

- Some colour combinations do not meet recommended contrast levels, which may affect users with visual impairments
- There is no 'skip to main content' link, which may cause navigation difficulties for keyboard or screen reader users
- Some images contain text or do not have meaningful alternative descriptions
- PDF documents are not consistently tagged for accessibility and may not be readable by assistive technology
- Some links are identified by colour only, making them harder to distinguish for some users
- Certain form elements lack accessible labels

We are currently working on resolving these issues and welcome feedback from users who encounter barriers.
