You must complete three squares in a row, passing vertically, horizontally or diagonally through the middle square.

This term we are celebrating diversity. Design a poster to celebrate the life of an inspiring person, past or present, who are either a different nationality, race or religion to you.	Create a piece of artwork on the circulation of the blood. This could be 2D or 3D.	Write a diary entry from the perspective of one of the characters from the Canterbury Tales. Describe your journey to Canterbury Cathedral.
Choose a village, town or city in the UK (other than Ashford) and produce a tourism leaflet to promote this place to others and encourage them to visit.	Write a letter from William Harvey to a friend, describing his journey towards discovering the circulation of the blood.	Choose a story from the Canterbury Tales, draw a series of stained glass windows to show key elements / events from the story.
Look at how transport has changed over time. Compare the past with the present, draw a time line or focus on one type.	Choose an historic place in Kent (other than Canterbury) to research. Produce a piece of work describing how it has changed since medieval times.	Produce an animation, picture, model, piece of artwork or any other creative task (e.g. music or sports based) on the theme of journeys.
