Weekly homework tasks

Reading

Read or share a book at least five times a week. This could be your 'Big Cat' Little Wandle book, your 'reading for pleasure' book or a book from home.

Mathletics

Mathletics homework will be set on a fortnightly basis. You can also use the games and challenges available on Mathletics as often as you like. The more, the better!

Phonics

Could you try and write some simple CVC words such as cat, pin, pat pot? Perhaps you could photograph yourself forming words in sand, shaving foam or glitter. You could make letter shapes with natural materials!
