


Ladybirds and Butterflies Homework Trail (Term 3 2025– 2026)

Off on the trail...



You must complete three squares in a row, passing vertically, horizontally or diagonally through the middle square.

Design or make a new shop sign for the bakery on Pudding Lane. Explain why you have chosen the images on your sign.	What would you do in London for a day? Write about your ideal day and illustrate this.	Create a piece of art work that shows London during the Great Fire.
Design your own information poster all about the Great Fire of London.	Pretend you are a Londoner during the time of the Great Fire of London. Write a letter to your parents telling them about the day you escaped the fire.	Write a poem based on the Great Fire of London. Can you use your senses?
Compare how fires were tackled in 1666 to firefighting today. You could use images, drawings or a paragraph. Use comparative conjunctions like however , therefore , although or but .	Design or make an apron for a baker. Label the materials will you use and explain why you chose them. Think about the purpose of a baker's apron.	Write a biography (life story) about some of the important people who were caught up in this historical event.
